

# STORMWATER ACTIVITY ONE



- \* Stormwater is rain that runs off roads, roofs and other hard surfaces, then flows down gutters and drains.
- \* Stormwater drains flow straight into streams and harbours.
- \* Stormwater is not treated in any way and it is usually polluted.

## What can you see that causes pollution?

(look in the gutters, around the drains, and perhaps where the stormwater pipe flows into a stream or beach)
