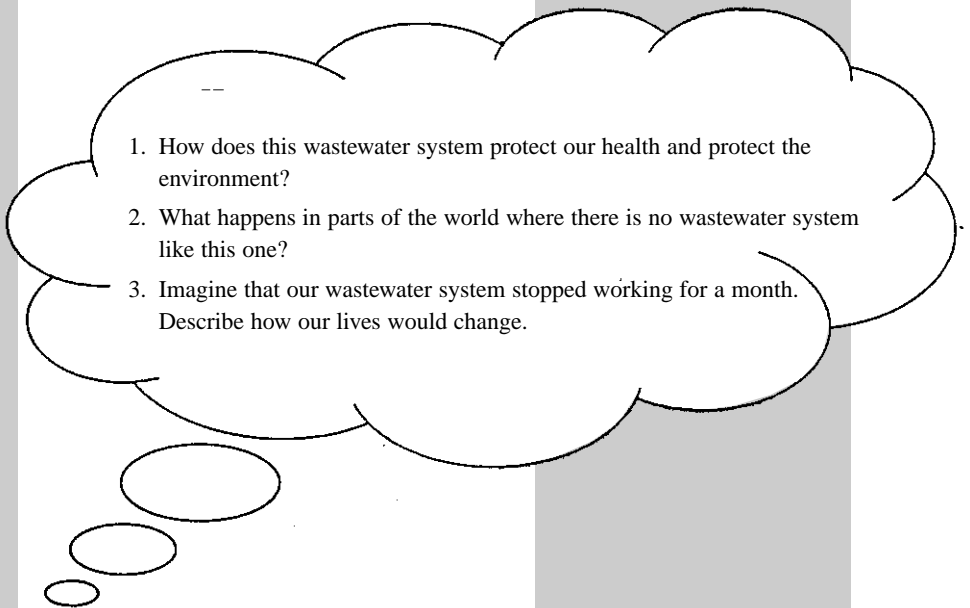
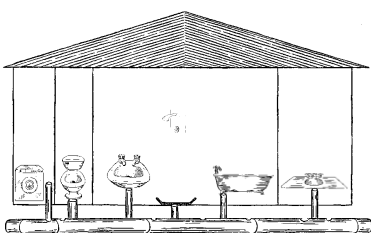
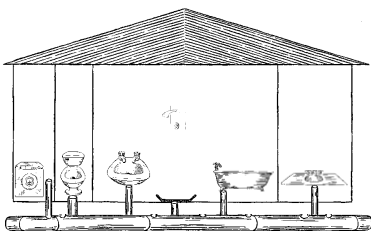
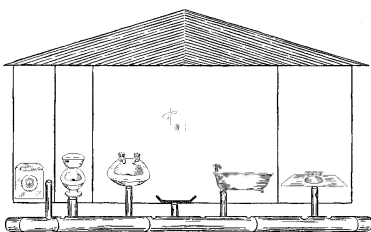
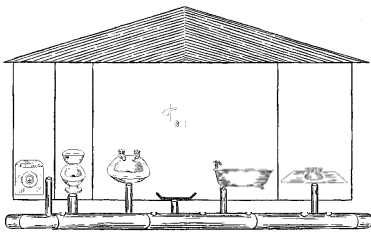
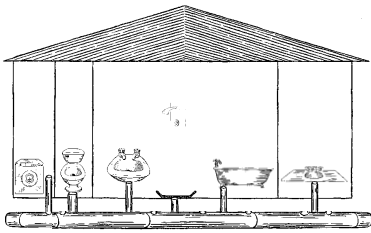
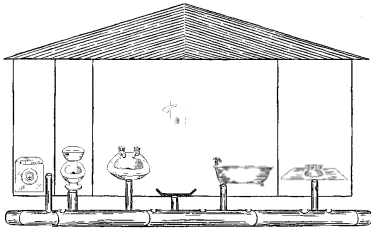


WASTEWATER ACTIVITY TWO
