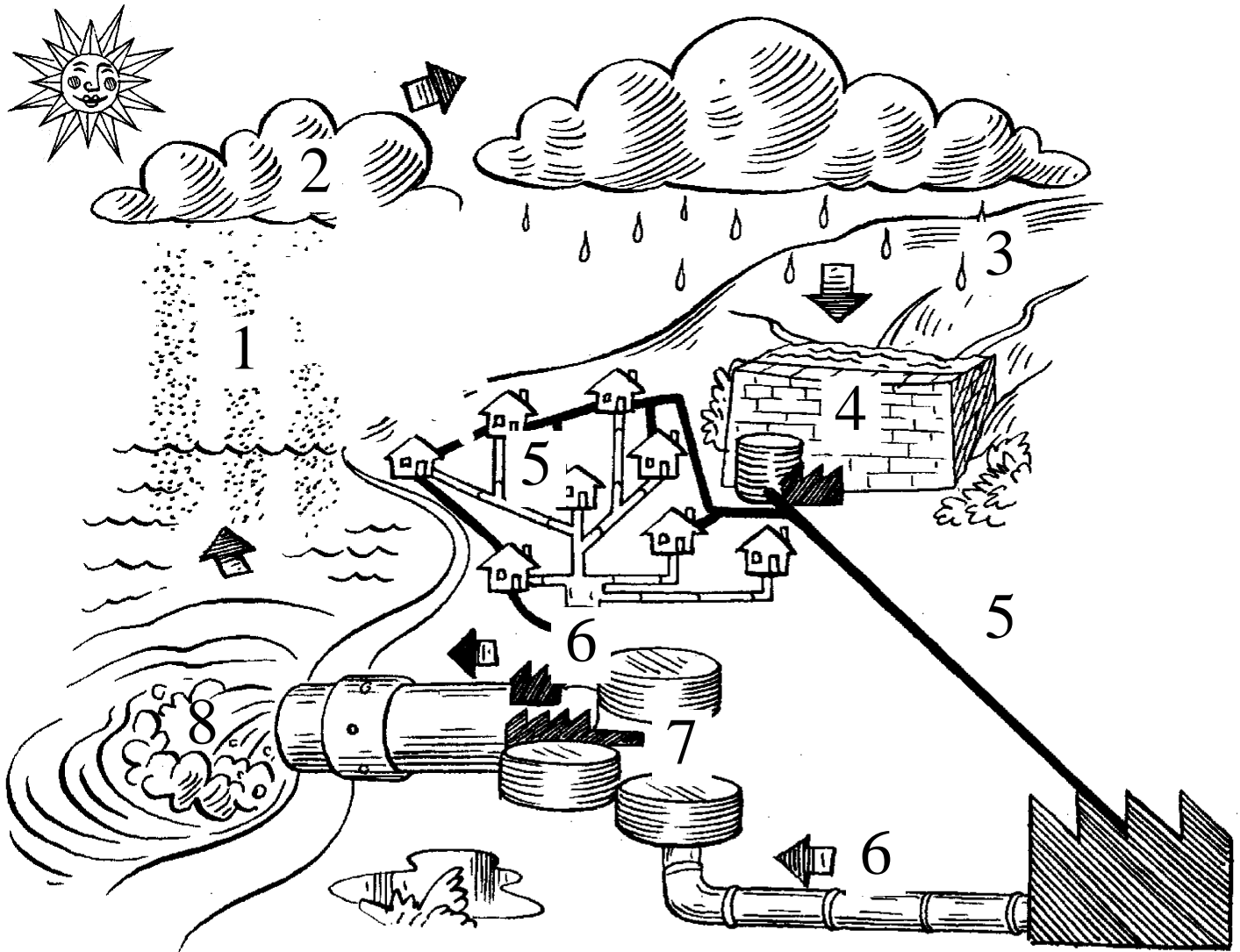


WASTEWATER ACTIVITY FOUR



If clouds become cold enough, rain will fall.

The wastewater treatment plant removes a lot of the pollution from wastewater

Water from dams is piped to houses, schools and factories.

Once wastewater has been treated, it is released into the sea.

Rain water is captured in storage dams then treated so it is safe for people to drink.

The sun's heat makes water evaporate from land, plants, sea, lakes and rivers. This evaporated water (water vapour) then rises into the atmosphere.

In the colder, upper atmosphere, water vapour condenses to form clouds

Wastewater is piped away from houses and other buildings to the wastewater treatment plant.
