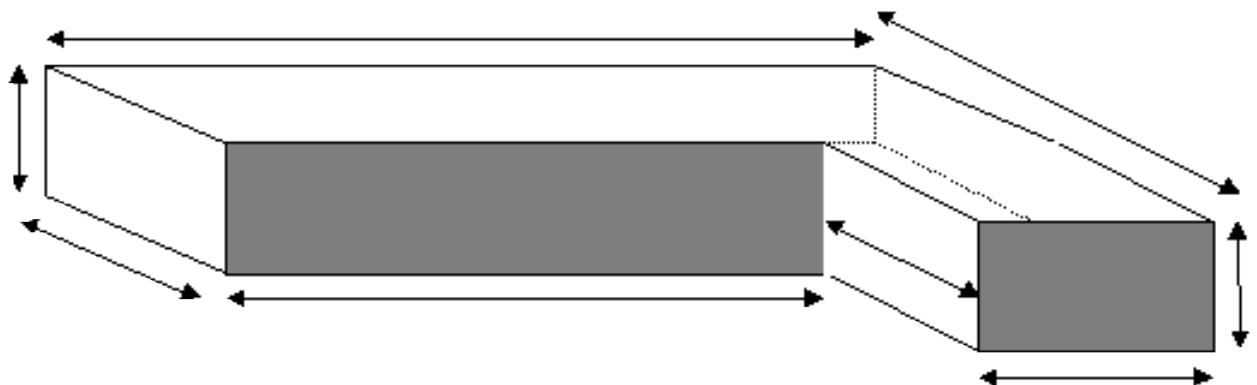
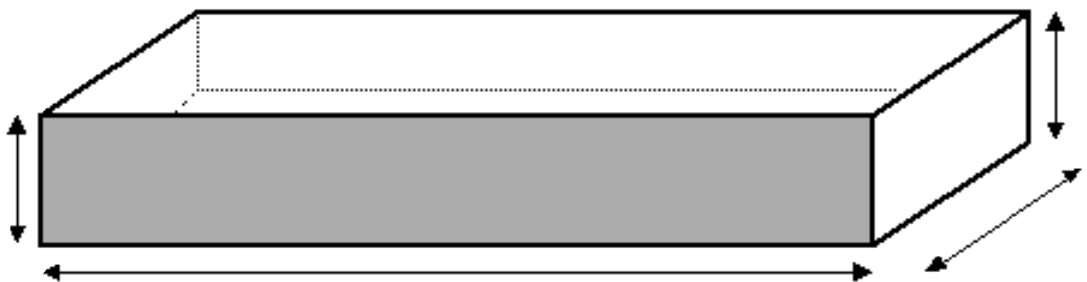
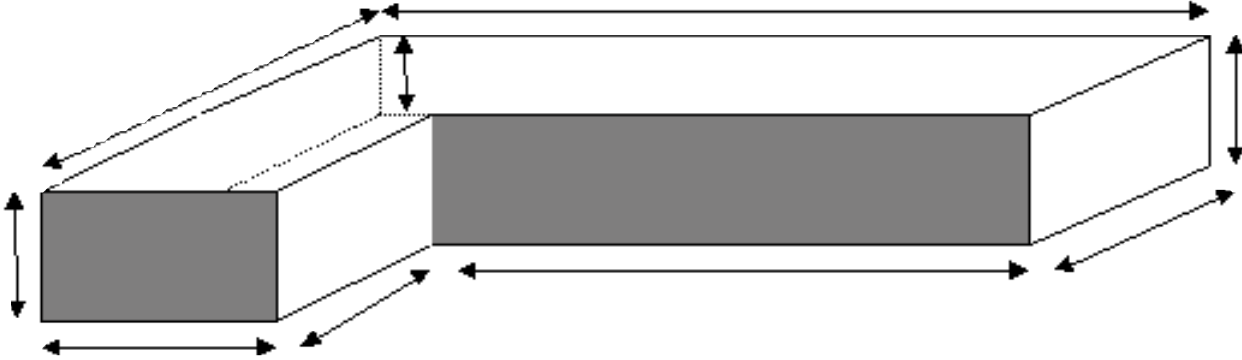


WATER USE ACTIVITY TWO

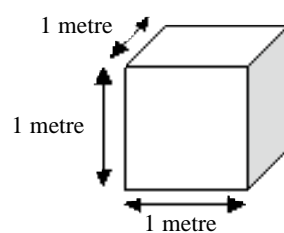
We measure large volumes of water in cubic metres.

In this activity, you will estimate how many cubic metres of water are in your school's swimming pool.

1. Choose the shape most like your school swimming pool and write in the measurements on the picture.



Here are the measurements of a cubic metre. (There are 1,000 litres in a cubic metre of water.)



2. Once you have measured the pool, find a way to estimate how many cubic metres it will hold. (clue: most primary school swimming pools in Waitakere City hold between 60 and 90 cubic metres of water.)
