

WATER USE ACTIVITY FIVE



Cut out a picture then find one box from column A, and one from column B to go with it. Do this for all the pictures then paste your finished work onto another piece of paper.

Column A

I help you prepare food, wash dishes, and have drinks of water.

I'm used for washing hands, faces, cleaning teeth, and sometimes shaving.

I help the plants grow in your garden and keep the car clean.

I am a quick way to get you clean. Football players love to stand under my warm water, and I'm good for washing hair.

Imagine how hard it would be to keep your clothes clean without my help.

I use a lot of water flushing away body wastes.

Fill me with warm water they lay down, relax and get clean.

Column B

People use about 100 litres of warm water. This just covers them when they lay down.

When you have my taps running to rinse dishes and wash vegetables, I use about 14 litres of water every minute.

When you have my taps running to wash hands and brush teeth, I use about 14 litres of water every minute.

I use 11 litres of water for each flush unless I'm 'dual flush'. Then I use about 3 litres for half, and 6 for full flush.

Every minute you stand under my warm water, I use at least 12 litres.

I use about 175 litres to wash a load of your dirty clothes.

Every minute you are watering the garden, washing the car, or just playing, I'm using about 14 litres.
