  - (a) That all existing parking restrictions or limitations (affected, or superseded, or replaced by this resolution) applicable to **SWANSON ROAD** imposed by any prior resolution (including resolution of any former authority) cease to have any force and effect as from the date of this determination provided however that any current enforcement action by way of prosecution arising from, or infringement notice issued in relation to, any non-compliance with or breach of any such parking restriction or limitation be authorised to be concluded in the normal manner.
  - (b) That, in accordance with the powers conferred by virtue of the Local Government Act 1974, The Transport Act 1962 and the Waitakere City Council Bylaw No. 7, 1991 - Traffic, the following parking limitations and restrictions be now resolved to be specified and imposed namely:
    - On the south kerb line of Swanson Road from a start point 117metres west kerb line of Rathgar Road to an end point 45metres further west, a **NO STOPPING AT ALL TIMES** control be put in place.
3. That the appropriate signage and /or markings, in accordance with the Traffic Regulations 1976, be hereby approved to be put in place to properly establish, delineate and record the said parking limitations and restrictions.
