
The Gala will be run in a very similar format to the one your team participated in two years ago. It was a really enjoyable day and we were impressed with your involvement.

I am happy to write detailing the support your club has given our school.



Without the help and generosity of people like yourselves our fundraising venture would not have been such a success.

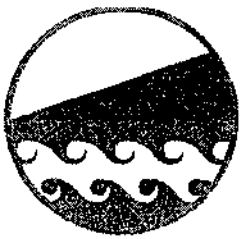
