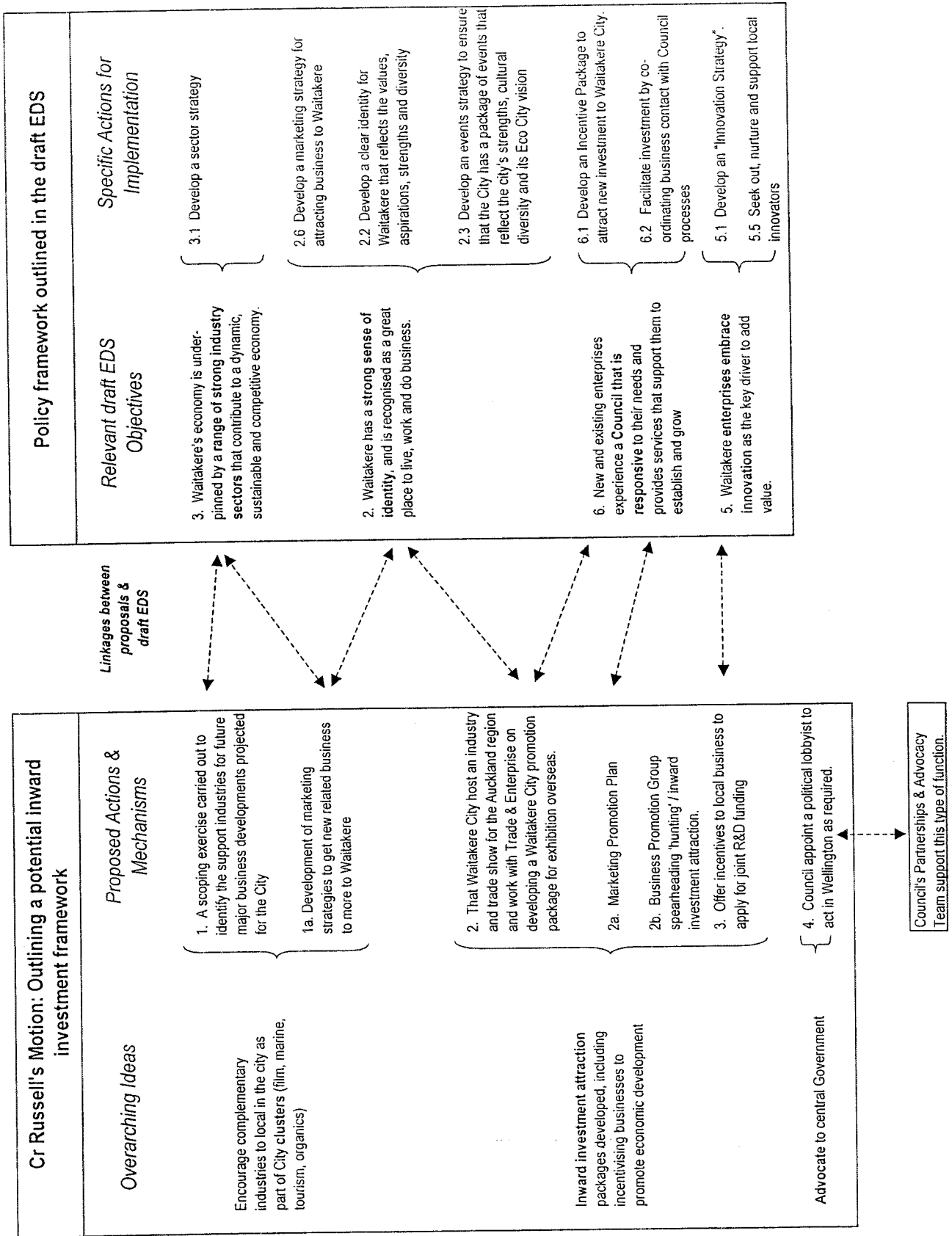


Relationship between draft EDS & proposed inward investment framework & Mayoral Marketing Taskforce
