



## Air Discharge Consents Information

As part of being an Eco City, Waitakere City Council and the Auckland Regional Council are trying to manage and reduce air pollution.

If you want to discharge anything into the air in Waitakere City, you may therefore need to obtain an Air Discharge Consent.

The Auckland Regional Council now processes all air discharge consents for Waitakere City. Prior to 1 July 2002, Waitakere City Council did process some types of air discharge consents, but this responsibility has been returned to the Auckland Regional Council. Waitakere City Council now has no role in the processing and monitoring of air discharge consents.

In the future, Waitakere City Council will only address complaints from the public related to air discharges that have not been given consent, for example a smoky backyard fire.

If you have any inquiries regarding your existing air discharge consent, you should now contact the Auckland Regional Council, as that Council will be undertaking the monitoring of all air discharge consents previously issued by Waitakere City Council.

If you wish to apply for an air discharge consent, you need to contact the Auckland Regional Council. The Regional Council will provide you with application forms and information regarding the processing and monitoring of air discharge consents.
