**BYLAW NO. 27 1995**

**SPRAY PAINT CANS**

The Waitakere City Council acting pursuant to the powers conferred upon it by the Local Government Act 1974 and all other powers and authorities enabling it hereby by Special Order makes the following bylaw:

**1 SHORT TITLE AND COMMENCEMENT**

The short title of this bylaw shall be the Waitakere City Council Bylaw No. 27 1995 – Spray Paint Cans and it shall come into force on 10 October 1995.

**2 PURPOSE**

The purpose of this bylaw is to protect Council property from graffiti defacement and to preserve public wellbeing by protecting Council and other property from graffiti defacement by forbidding the sale to persons under 16 years of spray paint cans.

**3 INTERPRETATION**

In this bylaw "spray paint can" means a container holding paint packed under pressure and able to be released as a fine spray.

**4 CERTAIN SALES PROHIBITED**

No person shall sell any spray paint can to any person under the age of 16 years.

**5 PENALTIES FOR BREACH OF BYLAWS**

- (i) Every person who mits a breach of this bylaw is liable to a fine not exceeding \$500 and, where the breach is a continuing one, then to a further fine not exceeding \$50 for every day or part of a day during which the breach has continued existence of any work or thing in a state contrary to this bylaw shall be deemed a continuing offence within the meaning of this clause.
