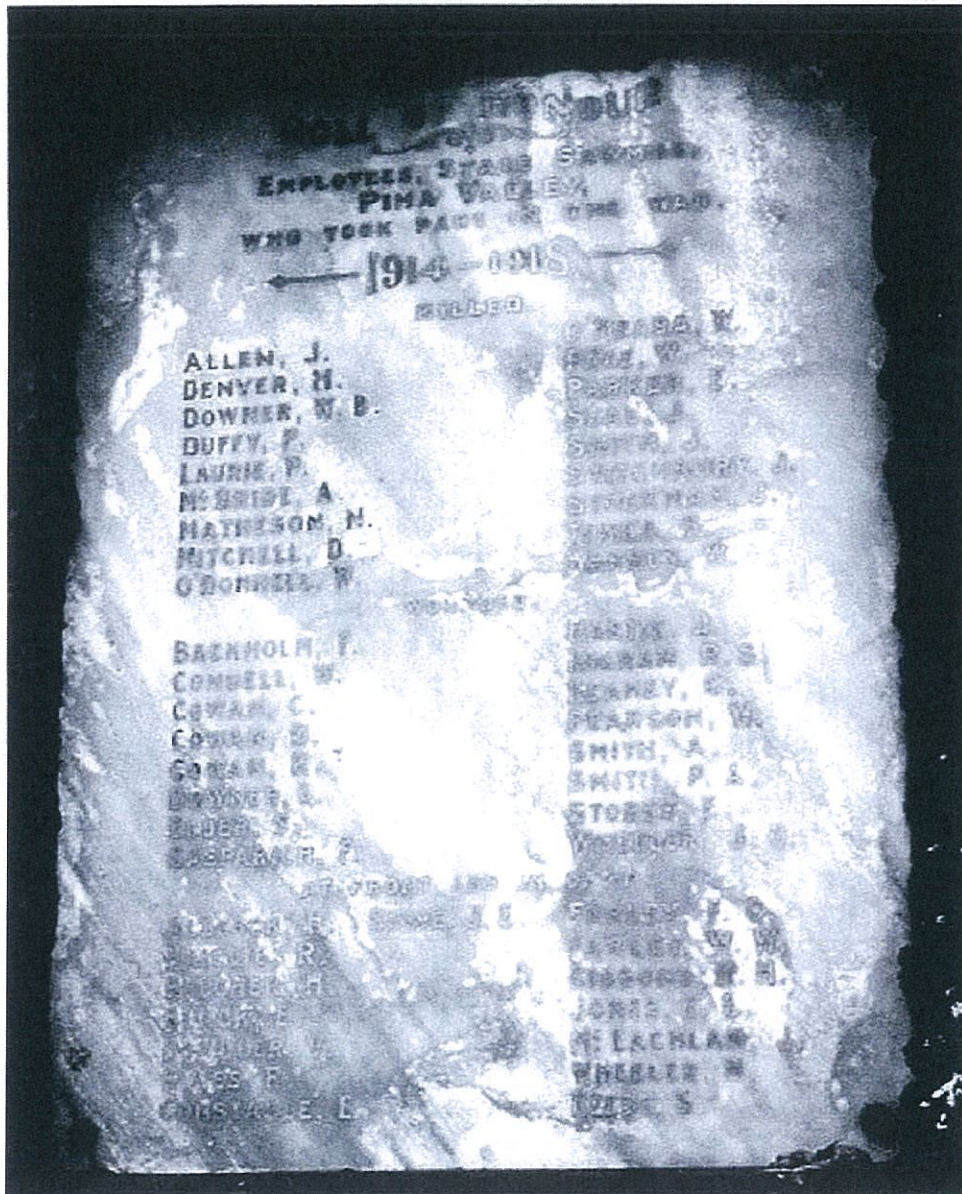

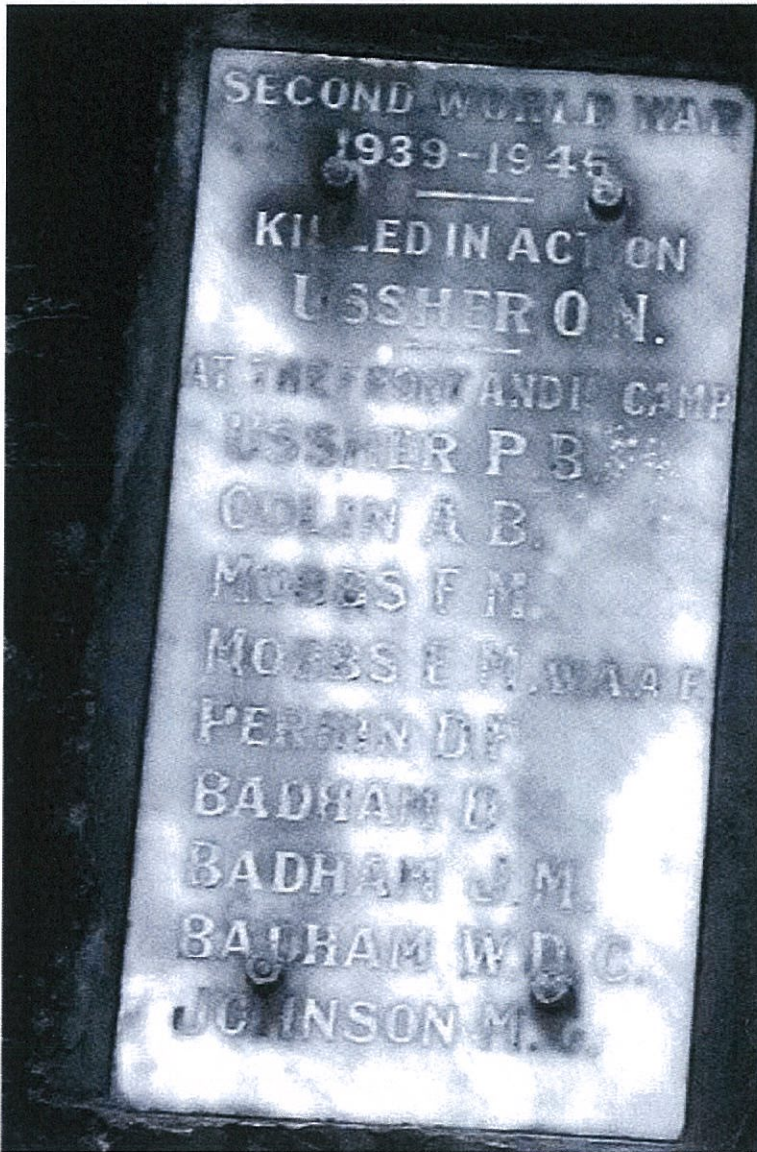
Anzac Day procession makes its way to Lion Rock, Piha's war memorial in 1985 or 1986. The service each year is held at low tide.

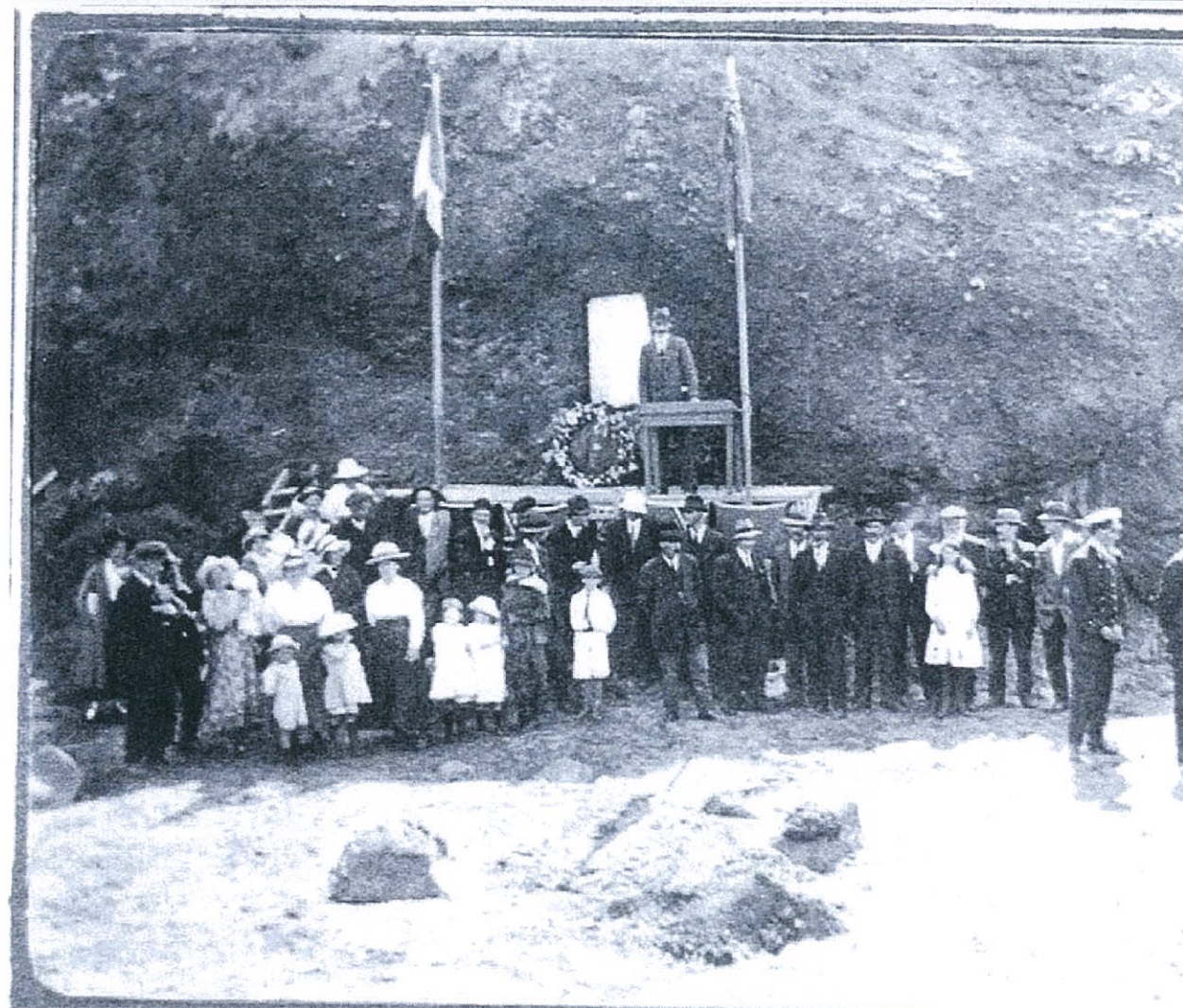

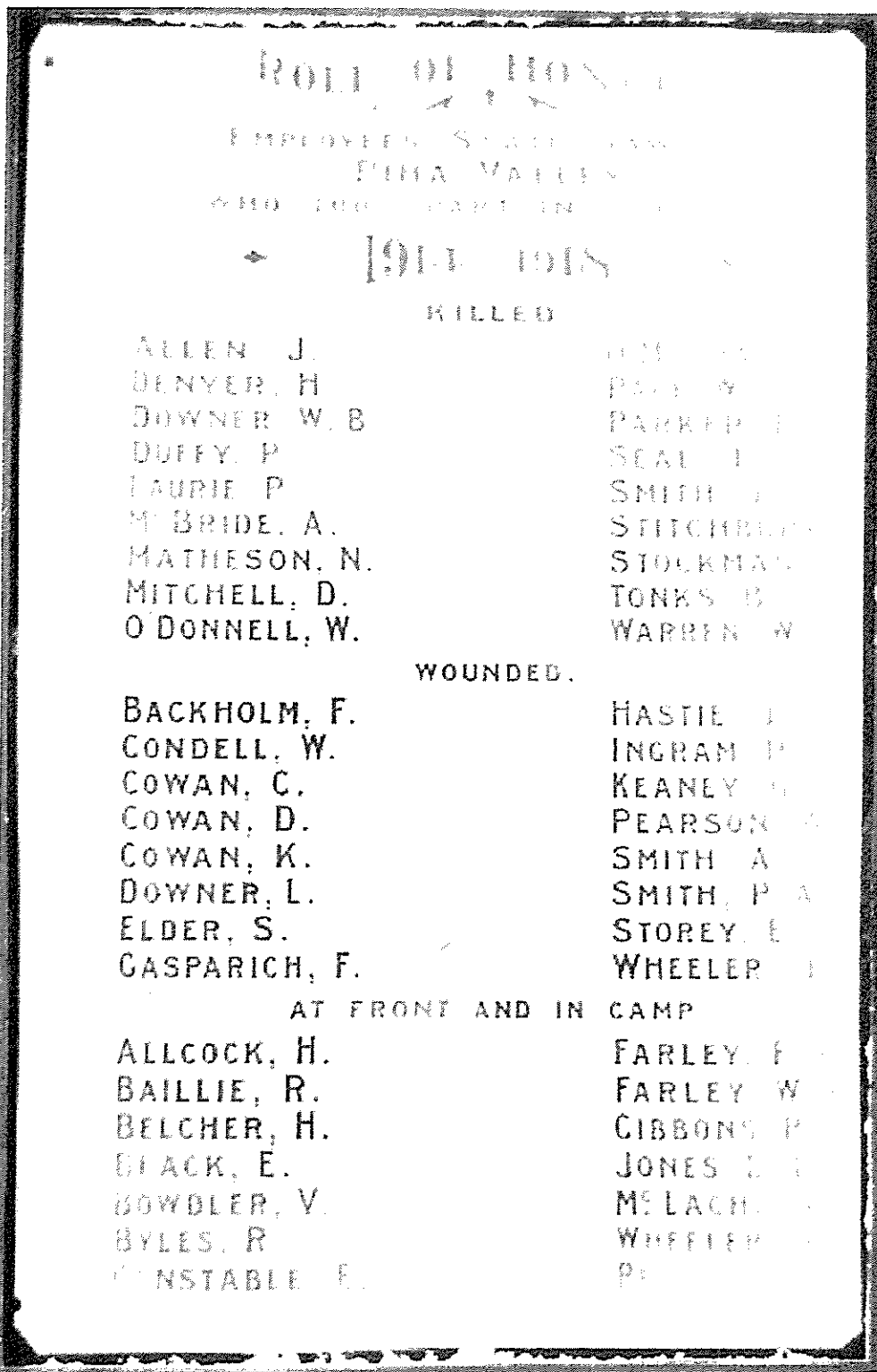
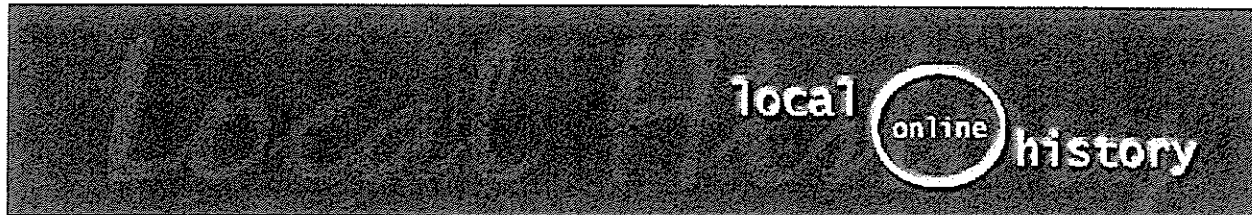
