This document is a Management Plan for the Waitakere City reserves of Te Rangī Hiroa and the reserves which lie adjacent to it, including Birdwood Winery Estate, Starling Park, Don Buck's Corner and Don Buck Primary School Recreation Reserve. Birdwood Depot is also included in this Plan. While not classified as a reserve, it is Council owned, freehold property adjacent to the reserves, and has the potential to make a significant contribution to the Te Rangī Hiroa reserves network.

This Plan has been developed as a guide to the protection, use and development of these reserves, with an emphasis on managing the reserves and their respective values as an integrated network as well as individual parks.
