

New rubbish & recycling services begin July 2005

What every business needs to know

From 1 July 2005, the rubbish and recycling collection services that Waitakere City Council provides businesses will change.

IMPORTANT:

The new changes apply to the Council's collection of "commercial household waste & recycling" as this is the only type of rubbish collected from businesses by the Council. This is the general rubbish and recycling generated by employees at meal and break times. The Council does not collect commercial solid trade waste or recycling generated by a business' operational activity. Businesses must make their own arrangements with private contractors to have commercial solid trade waste and recycling collected.

RUBBISH:

All businesses:

- Collected three times a week, on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays after 6pm.

RECYCLING:

New 140-litre mobile recycling bins will replace the existing green 45L crates and from 1 July the Council will collect recycling **fortnightly from the new mobile bins**. If your business would like to order a bin and participate in the new service, please complete the enclosed form and post it to the Council in the prepaid envelope supplied with this letter by 4pm on 16 May 2005. Forms received after this date may delay the delivery of your bin until after 1 July.

Crates can be returned to the Council for reuse in a future food waste collection service. If you wish to return your crate, then please place the Council-issued sticker (distributed with your bin) on your crate on its last collection day. The Council will collect stickered crates from 24-30 June.

COLLECTION DAYS:

Central Business Districts in Henderson, Glen Eden, New Lynn, Titirangi and Te Atatu:

- Collected fortnightly, on Tuesdays after 6pm, if your business is located in one of these commercial business districts (CBD). Please see reverse for a table of CBD boundaries.

Businesses outside the Central Business District areas:

- Collected fortnightly, on the same day as your area's residential recycling collection. Bins must be put out by 7.30am on your collection day. Please refer to reverse side for a table of rubbish collection days.

PAPER & CARDBOARD:

Please continue to place paper and cardboard in a bag (or tied with twine) and put it out separately next to your mobile recycling bin.

COLLECTION DAYS:

Central Business Districts in Henderson, Glen Eden, New Lynn, Titirangi and Te Atatu:

- Collected weekly, on Tuesdays after 6pm, if your business is located in one of these commercial business districts (CBD). Please see reverse for a table of CBD boundaries.

Businesses outside the Central Business District areas:

- Collected fortnightly, on the same day as your area's residential recycling collection. Bins must be put out by 7.30am on your collection day. Please refer to reverse side for a table of rubbish collection days.

Paper, cardboard and recycling must be placed out for collection by 7.30am.
