

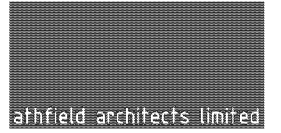

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Introduction

This report describes the development of the Proposed Henderson Station project which will adjoin the Waitakere Civic Centre at 2-6 Henderson Valley Rd, Henderson, Waitakere City.

The project consists broadly of 3 elements: the Double Tracking/Station Platform, the Bus Interchange and the Link Bridge. The subject of this report is the design of the Bus Interchange and the Link Bridge. The Station platform is to be developed and documented by others with input from the Henderson Station Consultant Team.

For this developed design stage, the proposal has been analysed and refined, based on the stated key brief objectives.

The process of developed design has been driven by consultation with the Council and the design meetings together with the Project Control Group and responds to Council representative and stakeholder feedback. Integration of design consultants' information and planning requirements, as well as constant checking against parameters such as brief guidelines and cost estimates also guided the design.

The Developed design process ensures satisfaction of specific user requirements and a well considered project, which will meet Council and Community expectations to produce a sustainable asset for Waitakere.
