- 1: That Councillors and Community Board members be elected by Ward.
- 2: That Community Boards be established with extended with extended delegations and authority.
- 3: That if the three (3) ward proposal is adopted the Community Boards in each Ward shall comprise seven (7) elected members.
- 4: The Henderson Community Board supports Option 2 as it better reflects communities of interest, the residents are better served by elected members who have intimate knowledge of the area and local issues and it also gives better access to elected members.

- Right turn from Keeling to Henderson Valley, Corban to Henderson Valley Road
- Does not support a bridge from Te Atatu to Massey
- Investigate a bridge from Matipu Road to the Concourse, or Taioma St
- Investigate a lifeline (back up road) from Te Atatu, possibly through the League Club
- Apologies from Wayne, Elizabeth, Leo, Helen, Steve McDonald
- Support for projects in Option 3
- HCB wants to be actively involved in the bus service review
- HCB supports park'n'rides be charged for security
- New footpaths – work through new prioritisation process on a city-wide basis:
 - footpaths connecting to bus stops and schools
 - get best value for money, not just large cost projects
- HCB to advise its top 10 priorities
- Slow streets – Waitaki Street and others – to be identified. Support budget for these
- Accident Investigation Study – Elizabeth and Ara to visit sites and confirm list
- Support proposed design at Te Atatu Road corridor improvements
- Signals required for crossing slip lane to the westbound on-ramp
- HCB wants Stevies Lane closed / or at least one way road (explore options)
- Rail station upgrade – HCB wants Council to advocate with ONTRACK to clean up the corridor
- Gunners Lane to be brought forward to 2006/2007
- Investigate Vitasovich Road traffic movement
- Swanson Road / Sturges Road to be brought forward to 2007/2008

I am applying for two months leave without pay from the Henderson Community Board.

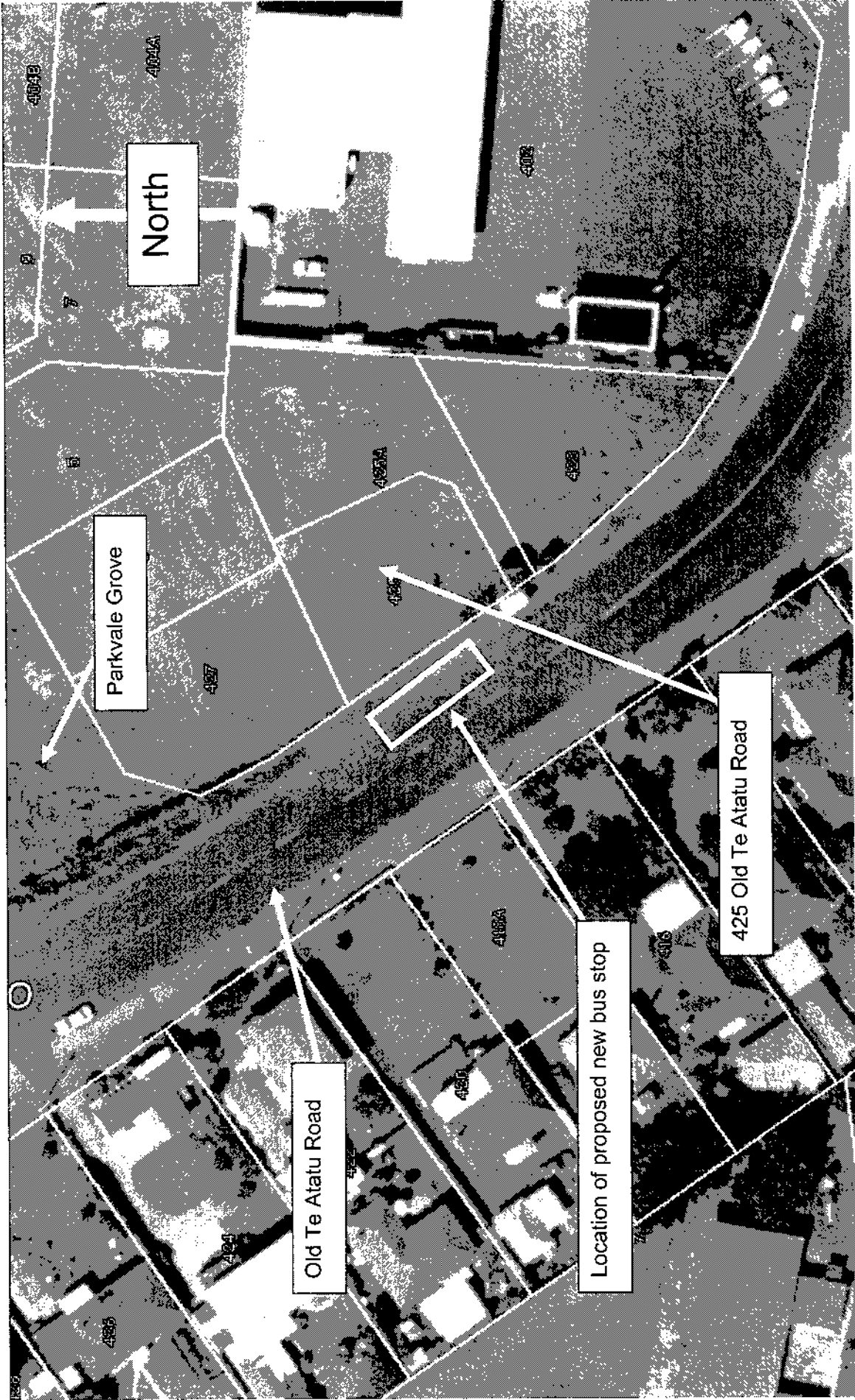
I will be overseas for May and June and will miss all meetings in this period.

I will be back on the 30th June.

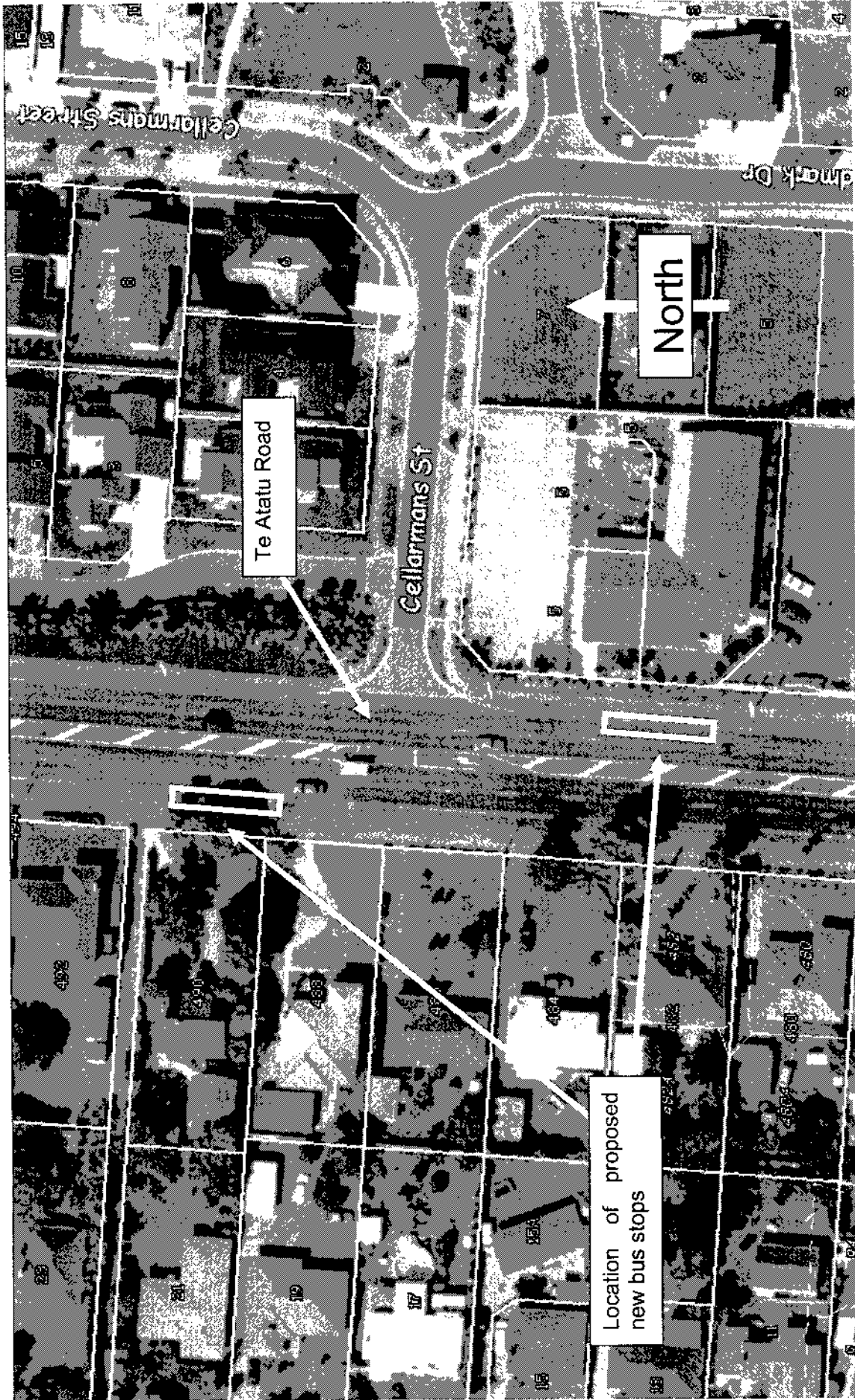
