**2 ROYAL COMMISSION ON AUCKLAND GOVERNANCE**

The Government has set up a Royal Commission to enquire into the question of Auckland's Local Government and how it is working.

The Commission has to:

- Examine the present system and how decisions are being made;
- Make recommendations about a system of Local and Regional Government that will best suit Auckland for the next 50–100 years;
- Ensure we have a system that will take into account Auckland's growth and its ethnic diversity.

At its simplest, the Commission's task asks the following two questions:

- Are you happy with the form of Local and Regional Government in Auckland?
- If not, what changes would you like to see?

The Commission is calling for public submissions and will be holding public hearings at which people may speak in support of those submissions. The deadline for submissions on the Royal Commission on Auckland Governance is 22 April 2008.

A presentation will be provided on:

- Council's view on the Commission's terms of reference;
- A number of issues relevant to community/neighbourhood governance;
- Suggestions for developing submissions.

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

It is recommended that the Massey Community Board resolves to:

1. **Receive** the presentation and form a working party to draft a submission to the Royal Commission on Auckland Governance on behalf of the Massey Ward residents.
2. **Note** in its submission the views expressed by the residents at the public meeting of the Massey Community Board, held on Monday, 7 April 2008.
