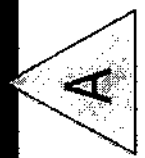
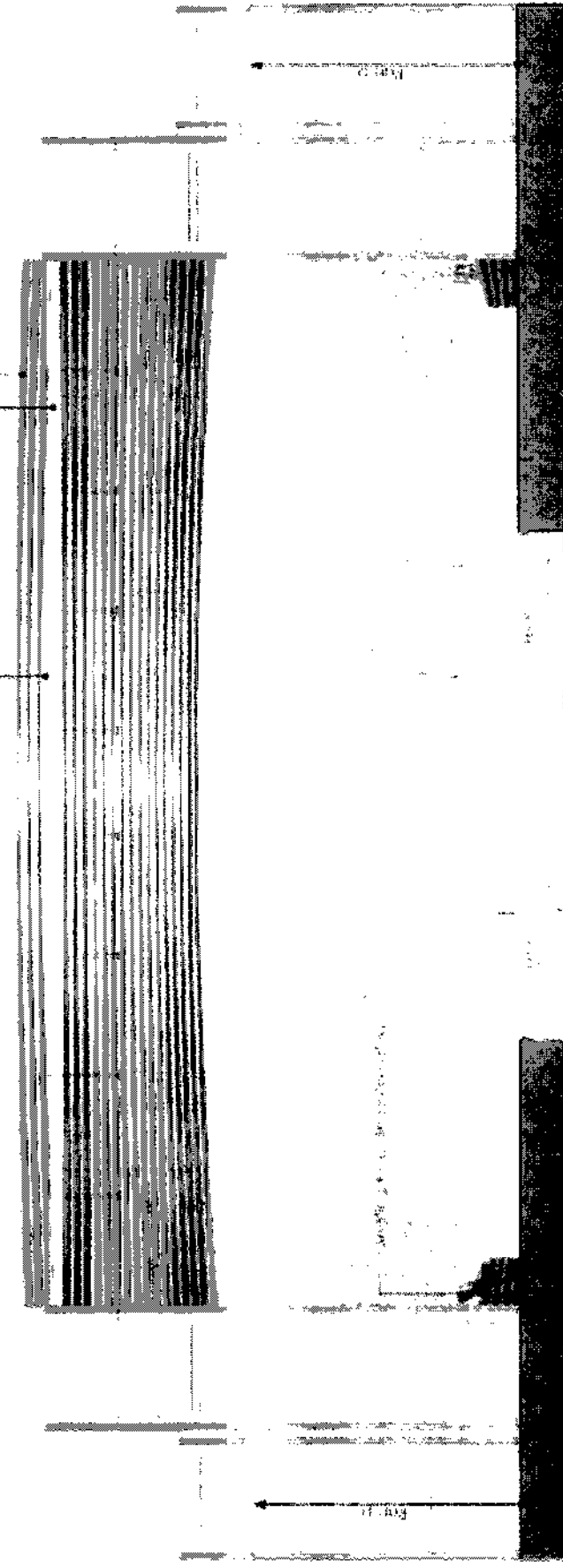

Dear Darren,

This letter is to confirm our offer of support during our meeting on Tuesday 17 April, 2007 for a graffiti clean up trial along the rail corridor at Henderson.

As discussed, the trial area will be between Mt Lebanon Lane and Bruce McLaren Road, excluding the Henderson Valley Road Bridge (Bridge 57) and the station area maintained by the Auckland Regional Transport Authority.

Following completion and signing of the Permit to Enter and Indemnity document, (sample attached) ONTRACK will commit safety advice and training resources to a pilot team that is assembled and funded by Waitakere City Council (WCC). The support will involve:

1. A waiver of the Permit to Enter fee for the project
2. Safety advice from the HSE Coordinator to assist WCC develop a safety plan that meets ONTRACK requirement (based on the Manukau Beautification Trust trial)
3. Rail safety induction
4. Protection training (ITD-R) for supervisory staff if appropriate and identified in the safety plan.

Given the nature and risks involved with working on the railway corridor, ONTRACK expects the team assembled will include key supervisors engaged on a permanent basis to directly supervise and manage the safety of the pilot team. ONTRACK reserves the right to alter or cancel the Permit to Enter should safety issues or other issues arise.

The trial be limited to a maximum 12 month period after which it will be subject to evaluation and review by all parties involved, prior to deciding the future of the project.

Please keep us up to date on how funding for the resources necessary to run the trial progresses. In the meantime, we look forward to working with your organisation to develop this pilot and helping to clean the rail corridor.

/left Massey to move to Glen Eden as bad things happened, safer in Glen Eden, too hard round here, need for parenting programmes to help /parent education /Toolbox Teenage Courses, 6 weeks, 2 hours per week

### **03 Talking to them**

/listen to them, ask what they want to do, try to understand them more /more social workers /youth workers /get involved in saying what they want

### **04 Drug and alcohol programmes**

/awareness of drugs, bullying /more events like Raise Up n Represent

### **05 Sporting activities**

/sport involvement, community as well as competition /netball club /sport that does not start so early after school /YMCA good, use that already /more sport events for teens /costs \$2000 for fees for basketball, should be subsidised /more resources, basketball courts /more community games /make use of park, someone doing things with them at basketball courts /basketball jams /skateboard ramp, have to go to Te Pai Park /bring BMX track up to scratch

### **06 Regular events**

/Whanau Day, hip hop dancing excellent, keep boys interested and occupied /Youth Spacer, a boot camp that teaches to develop leadership, get them on right track /youth development programmes to keep them out of trouble /youth events like they have at the Leisure Centre /weekly event at recreation centre, always hanging out at Westgate /organised events with other teens /events after school and on the weekends

#### **07 One off events**

/places to hang out for entertainment, more concerts and free movies /more entertainment, used to live in Te Atatu where gangs were trouble /more night time events /youth events, music always attracts attention /tree planting projects for Youth

#### **08 Other single mentions**

/support for teen mums, daughter travels to Grey Lynn /get them to help elderly and one another /set up youth teams and work with teens /little bit of discipline, tell where boundaries are and help them with it /make them go to school, truants hang around and cause trouble /place options, what part time work is available, supplement income and work experience /need express bus from Westgate to Auckland University and AUT North Shore or student subsidy with Richies /neighbourhood support networks /get rid of Massey's reputation, would be good if things were happening and they could take pride in city /promoting Recreation Centre

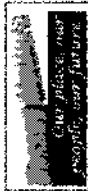
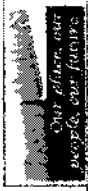
#### **09 Youth centre/youth facilities**

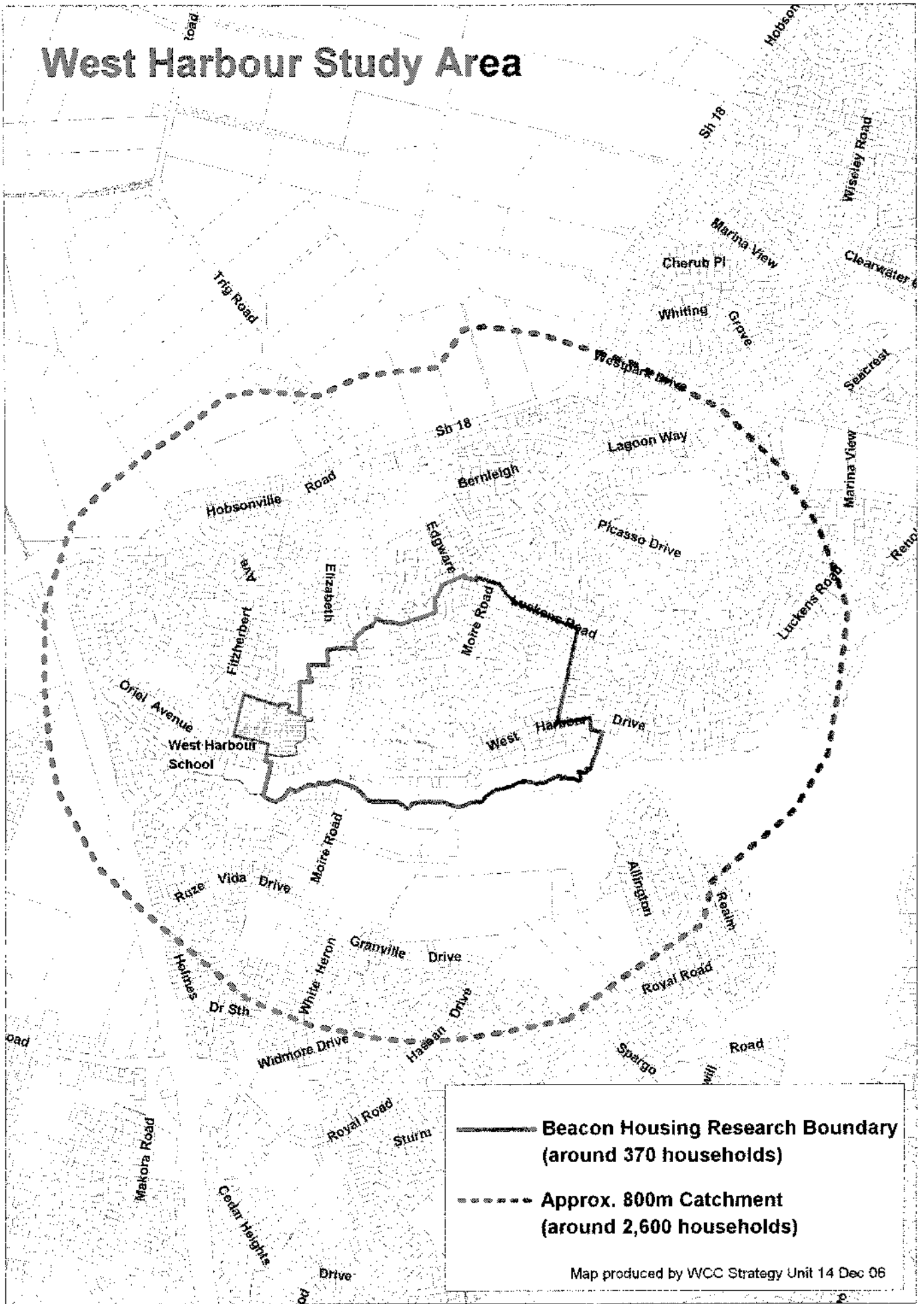
