

## PASSENGER TRANSPORT SUB-COMMITTEE: DRAFT TERMS OF REFERENCE

### Purpose

To facilitate the smooth implementation of the Passenger Transport elements of the Regional Land Transport Strategy (RLTS).

### Scope

The sub-committee will act in an advisory and information-sharing capacity, and co-ordinate the activities of the respective local authorities and other public agencies with responsibilities for implementing passenger transport. In particular, the sub-committee will:

- Receive regular reports on the various aspects of implementing passenger transport.
- Liaise with its parent Committee, the ARC Passenger Transport Committee, relevant territorial authority committees, the ARTNL Board, and the ARTNL Shareholder Representation Group, on all aspects of passenger transport.
- Recommend actions to the agencies responsible for implementation of passenger transport projects, and co-ordinate the implementation of multi-agency projects.
- Facilitate relations with local authorities, ARTNL, government agencies, service providers, Infrastructure Auckland, and other external organisations on matters associated with the implementation of passenger transport.
- Advise the Regional Land Transport Committee on any passenger transport policy issues which may require action by that Committee.
- Advise the Regional Land Transport Committee and Passenger Transport Committee on the monitoring of performance towards implementation of RLTS passenger transport policies, and the achievement of RLTS targets.

### Membership

Membership of the sub-committee shall be as follows:

- Up to three members appointed by the Auckland Regional Council (including the Chair and deputy Chair of the Passenger Transport Committee).
- One member appointed from each of the territorial authorities in the region.
- One member appointed by Transit New Zealand.
- One member appointed by Auckland Regional Transport Network Limited (ARTNL).

Appointed members may be elected representatives or officers.

13-16 April, Brisbane Queensland Australia**

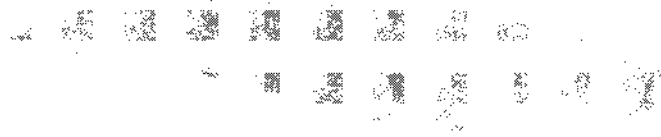


Your support for this initiative would be invaluable and I take great pleasure in inviting you to participate in the 2003 Asia Pacific Cities Summit next year.

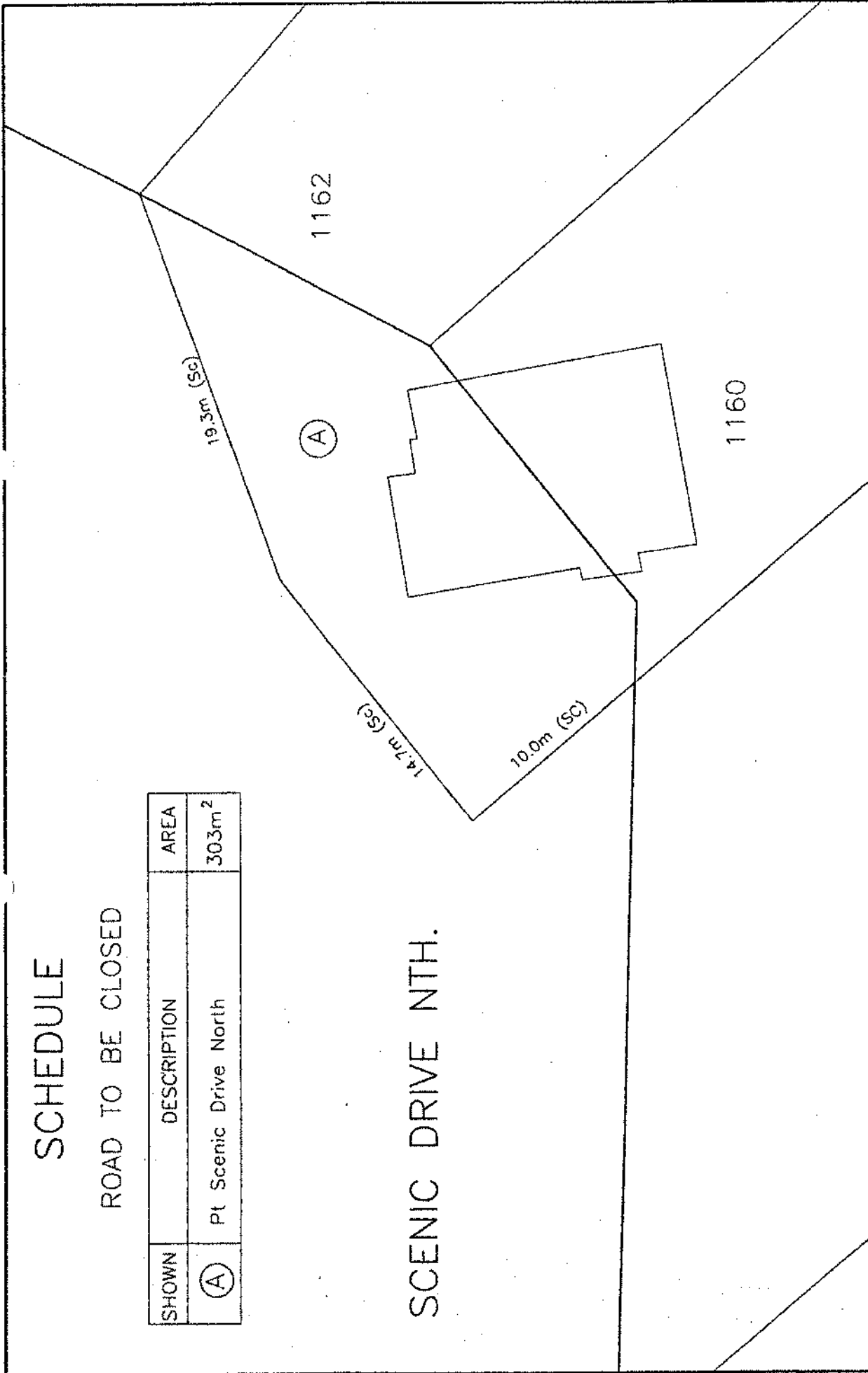

I thank you for the petition that you organised from residents of Mt Roskill and Lynfield offering their support for the Whenuapai airbase to be retained for reasons of strategic security. I will ensure that the Council receives it at the next full Council meeting.

I note that you are particularly opposed to state housing on the site. Personally I think that we have enough state housing in the region after the Crown determined to build a large number on Hobsonville. However the Crown have a wide variety of rights over it as the owners. We will wait and see precisely what their timetable and plans are for the site, and in the meantime work to ensure that we do not lose the option for an airbase in the future.

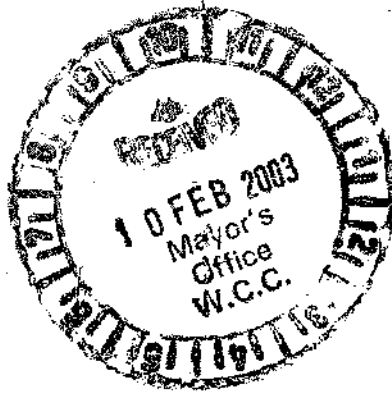
