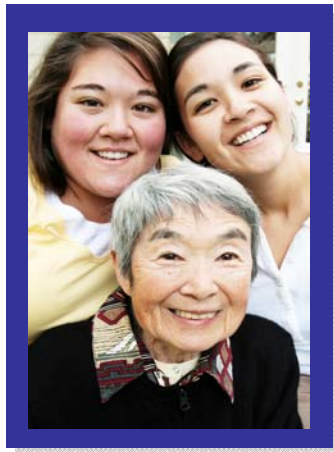


Teen Triple P-Positive Parenting Programme
