What are Access Services?

Access Services are provided to assist in overcoming barriers to accessing the libraries, the library's services and its collections.

What Access Services are available?

The Mobile Library

The Mobile Library carries collections of materials for both adults and children and visits urban centres and rural locations around the city, including stops at schools, rest homes and retirement villages.

Outreach library services

Home delivery of library materials is provided for those individuals who have difficulty accessing library branches because of illness, disability or impaired mobility. Books and other library materials are selected on behalf of patrons and delivered to those who are housebound and without a support network. The service can be tailored to suit individual requirements and can be provided for short or long term periods.

Services to rest homes and retirement accommodation

Outreach services are provided to residents of resthomes and retirement villages. In addition the Waitakere Library mobile bus stops at a number of retirement villages and resthomes.

Who is the Access Librarian?

The Access librarian will assist those with disabilities or special needs to access collections and services.

Library resources include

- Talking books on tape or CD
- Captioned videos
- Large print books
- Magnifying sheets available at all libraries
