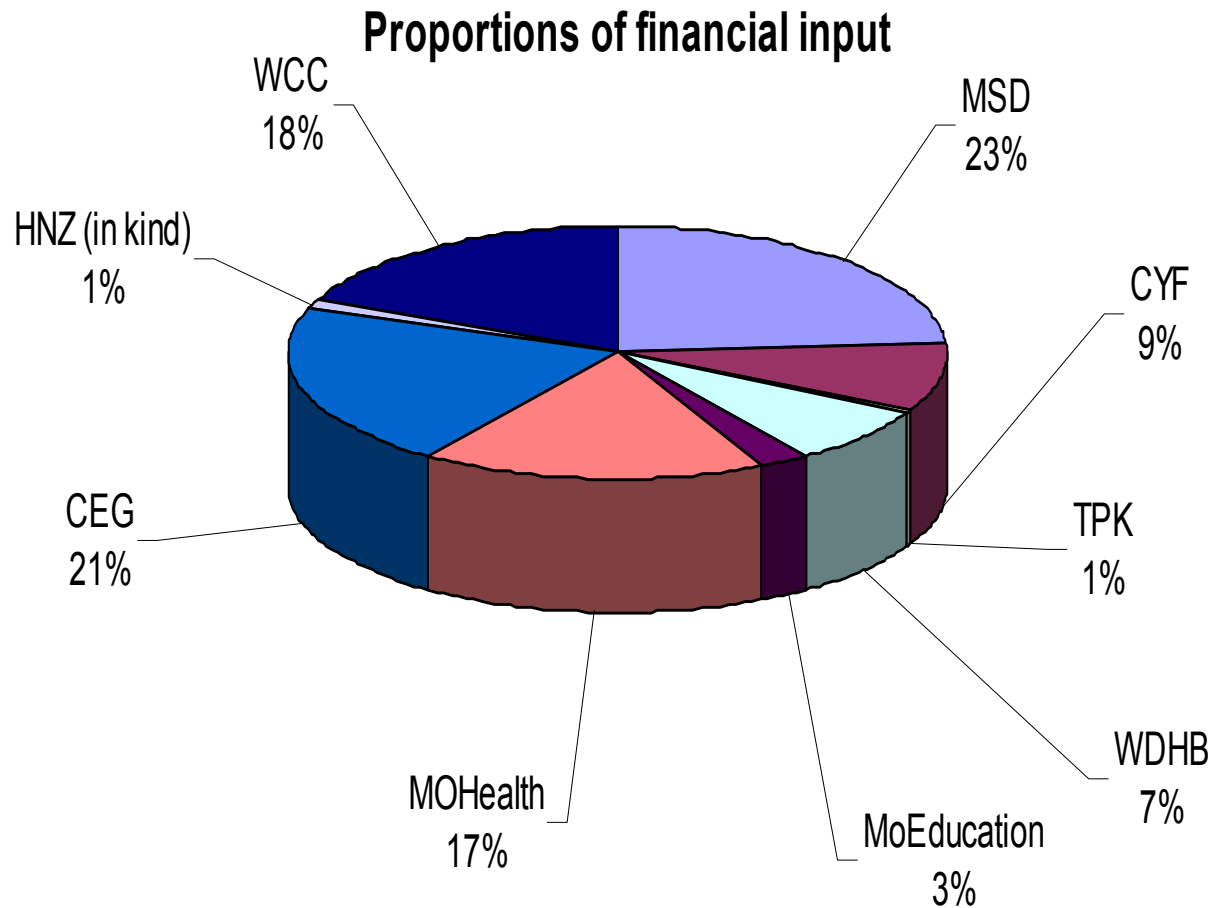

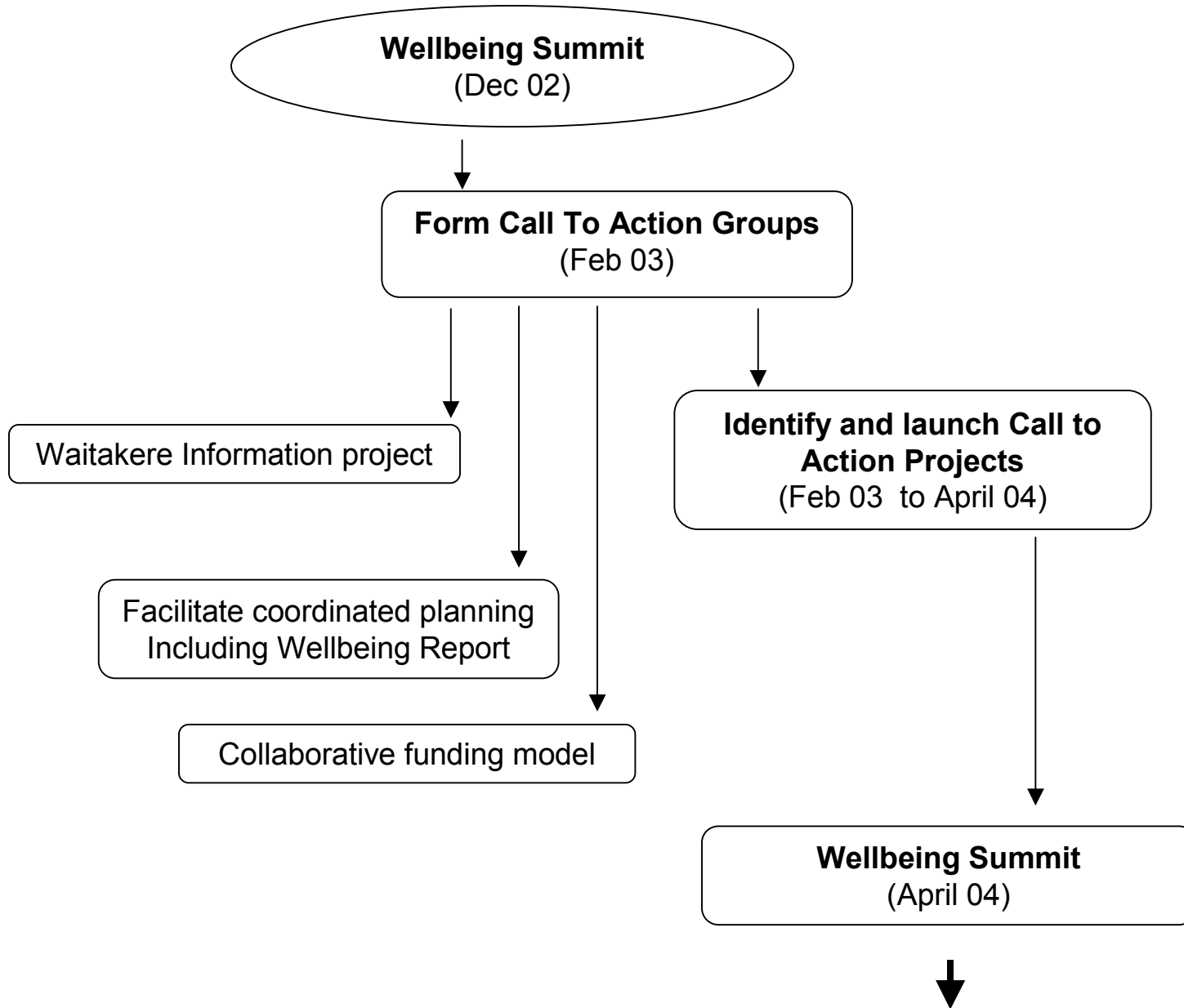


# The Waitakere Wellbeing Collaboration Project

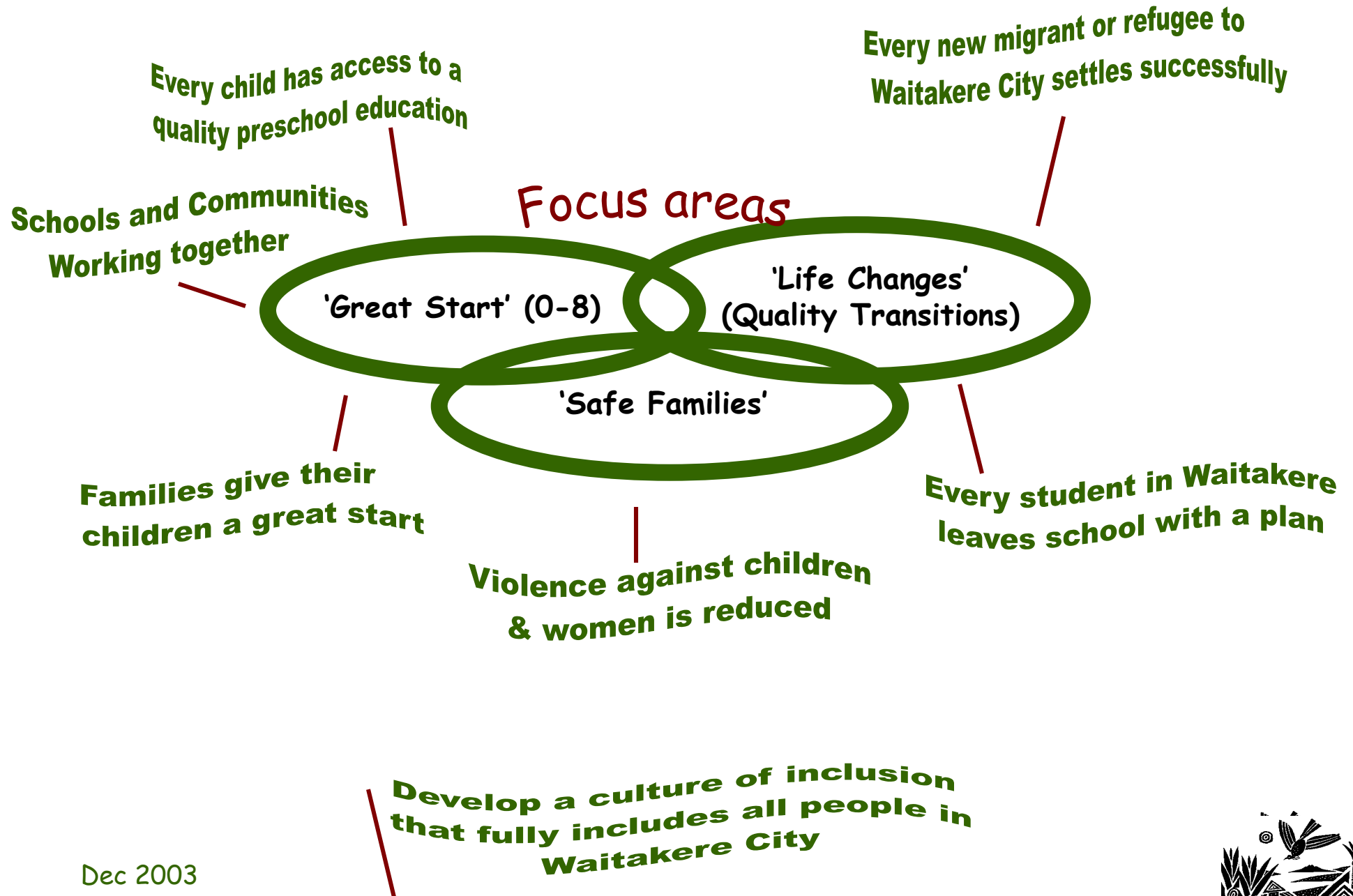

ie the understanding of the information,  
the distillation of knowledge &  
promotes its utilisation in business planning
